The WTA publishes the only annual world rankings for commercial teleport operators, including independent operators, satellite carriers, fibre carriers and technology providers. Rankings are based on total revenue and year-on-year growth and with more than 1,800 teleports operating worldwide, a ranking in any top twenty category is impressive and a sign of world-class status.

Bell said: “We’re very pleased to welcome CET Teleport to the Independent Top Twenty list, which ranks the world’s independent teleport operators by annual revenue growth. Their #11 position on the Fast Twenty, which is based on revenue growth, says even more. CET Teleport is growing their business, even in tough economic times, in the best entrepreneurial traditions of the teleport sector.”

CET Teleport CEO Ken Armstrong said: “It is less than two years since CET Teleport bought the Hameln teleport from Stratos and in that time we have transformed it such that we are now recognised as a very serious player in the satellite service provision industry.
